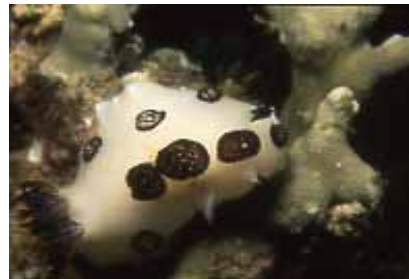
## MONTHLY MEETING TOPIC
