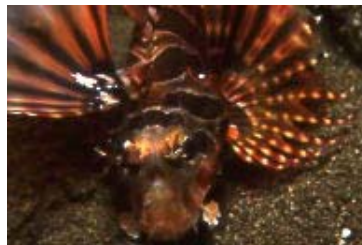
MONTHLY MEETING TOPIC

The annual Dive Equipment Manufacturing Association (DEMA) was held October 13-16 in Houston at the George R. Brown Convention Center. Since it was within driving distance, many Texas diving professionals turned out for the show but that didn't help the low attendee turnout this year. Several of the major scuba manufacturers opted not to exhibit at this show but none claimed that they were boycotting the event. Another reason for the low turnout was that DEMA was cracking down on who could attend the event to increase the "quality" of those walking the exhibit hall and decrease "end users." Exhibitors did say they had more time to talk to their customers that did make equipment purchase and travel contracts.

Camera-related manufacturers were there in full force to show off their latest housings and equipment, plus provide seminars for tips on how to improve photo and video techniques. The Los Angeles Underwater Photographic Society was on hand to display some of their photos.
